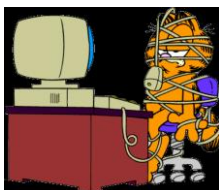

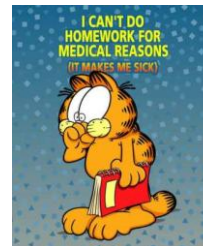
APOLOGIZING
