

LOS ANGELES (AP) — California Gov. Arnold Schwarzenegger has signed an anti-paparazzi bill making it easier to sue media outlets that use photos that invade celebrities' privacy. introduction

The former Terminator star signed an amendment Sunday to a decade-old law that allows fines against paparazzi who illegally or offensively take photos or make recordings. The amendment permits lawsuits against media outlets that pay for and make first use of material they know was improperly obtained.

Tabloid magazines, TV shows and Internet sites sometimes pay millions for celebrity fodder1.

In 1998 Schwarzenegger had his car surrounded by paparazzi as he picked up his child from school. Other stars have had car accidents while trying to flee swarms of photographers.

The amendment takes effect in January.
